**to Our State Elected Officials to Support SJR 127**

**SJR 127 – A proposed amendment to the Tennessee Constitution to reverse the 2000 Sundquist v. Planned Parenthood decision that created a “right” to abortion.**

“Nothing in this Constitution secures or protects a right to abortion or requires the funding of an abortion. The people retain the right through their elected state representatives and state senators to enact, amend, or repeal statutes regarding abortion, including circumstances of pregnancy resulting from rape or incest or when necessary to save the life of the mother.”

We, the undersigned, believe that the people through their elected Representatives, not judges, should decide the state’s abortion policy. For 130 years the Tennessee Constitution did not take the pro-abortion side on the abortion issue, until a state Supreme Court decision in the year 2000. The courts have made our Constitution say something that it doesn't.

I urge you to vote for Senate Joint Resolution 127, as adopted by the state Senate during the 2008 General Assembly, so we can amend our state Constitution to reverse the state Supreme Court’s bad decision and to pave the way to stop partial-birth abortion in Tennessee and enact other commonsense protections for women and children.
